Hurricane Supply Kit

Documents: ID card, social security card, insurance, phone numbers, activities for children

Food/Water: bottled water, canned food, manual can opener, baby food, vitamins, pet food

Safety: rain gear, blankets/pillows, flashlight, sturdy shoes, portable radio/batteries, medication, toiletries

HURCON 2

<p>HURCON IV</p> <p>Within 72 hours</p>	<p>Monitor local television, radio and the commander's access channel (Channel 7 on base). Gather business supplies, important documents (see list at right) and locate nearest shelter. If evacuating, call the Air Force Personnel Center at 1-888-488-9844 before leaving the area. Drive away from the coast. Interstate highways will be congested.</p>
<p>HURCON III</p> <p>Within 48 hours</p>	<p>Continue monitoring local news. If remaining in the area, ensure vehicles are full of fuel. Check on family and friends without transportation or those with deployed spouses.</p>
<p>HURCON II</p> <p>Within 24 hours</p>	<p>Monitor radio/TV for updates. Secure outdoor items such as lawn furniture, umbrellas and children's toys. Unless directed to evacuate, move to shelter. Cover all windows. If shutters have not been installed, use plywood.</p>
<p>HURCON I</p> <p>Within 12 hours</p>	<p>Monitor radio/TV for updates. Bring pets inside. Check tie-downs on manufactured homes. Stay inside away from windows, skylights and glass doors during the storm. Watch for tornadoes. Avoid flood waters.</p>
<p>POST</p> <p>After the hurricane</p>	<p>Monitor radio/TV for updates and instructions. Avoid standing water and downed electric lines. Inspect your home for damage. In case of power outage, use flashlights, not candles. Turn electrical appliances off to reduce "surge" when power is restored.</p>


