

#### Predeployment brief

The next predeployment brief is scheduled for March 4 from 8 to 9:30 a.m. It's mandatory for those departing on deployments of 30 days or more. It covers family separation and antiterrorism measures. Unit deployment managers with 10 or more deploying personnel should contact the FSC to coordinate a mass briefing. 


